## 2014 Spectator Drag Rules

As an extra added attraction for all concerned, Spectator Drags will be held each week of the season. The rules are very simple.

They are as follows:

Spectator Drags Rules for 2014

- All Cars, SUV's or Trucks must be street legal with current license plates, insurance and safety devices in place such as seat belts, headlights, etc.
- All entrants cars must have DOT approved tires, no slicks or race tires of any kind.
- All entrants must be at least 18 years of age.
- All entrants must provide a current registration or title to prove ownership.
- All entrants must provide their own helmet, full face or otherwise.
- Effective April 26, 2014
- All Spectator Drag Participants need to sign in at the back gate and pay **\$20** for the driver and any other passengers.
- Participants then need to park as a group just outside the pit gate on the right hand side and wait for further instructions. The wrist band issued will not allow access to the pits.
- Each vehicle will have a SPEC and a number put on their windshield with white shoe polish.
- When the time comes for the Spectator Drag competition, the entire group of Spec Drag racers will enter the race track and infield at the same time.
- All vehicles will be lined up ready to enter the racing surface.
- After each run, the winners will go to one line and the losers yet another.
- When the competition is over, the group of Spec Drag racers will leave together. No one can stay in the infield.
- Spec Drag competitors can then pull around to the grandstand and watch the rest of the evenings activities at no additional charge.

Two vehicles at a time will be chosen to race, then flip a coin to decide who will start on the inside or outside lanes.

The two vehicles line up, flagman waves the flag and two racers take off. The first vehicle back to the line is declared the heat winner and will line up in the infield as part of the winner's lane. The loser goes to the losers lane and is done for the night.

After single round eliminations is done, the two finalists will line up and run the first

heat. This is a best two out of three arrangement with the second heat entrants swapping the inside and outside positions.

Whoever wins two heat in the finals is declared the overall winner.

Awards and Prizes

- If there are five cars or less, the winners receives \$50 and a trophy.
- If there are 10 or more cars, the winner receives \$100 and a trophy.

**Note:** This class is designed to allow spectators to have some **FUN** and test their talents in driving a car. Any <u>intentional crash inflicting hits</u> will result in the driver being escorted off the Shenandoah Speedway premises and face a <u>permanent ban</u> from the property.
