General Rules

We will be running under 2014 NASCAR Late Model Rulebook. Except for the following below:

Shocks

Open Shock Rule (Any shock allowed at S.S.)

Muffler

- **1.** Any muffler may be used at S.S. Mufflers must be capable of maintaining a maximum of 80 DECIBALS at the Property Line. (Per County Regulations)
 - 2. If a car should exceed the maximum decibel level, at any time, it will be disqualified until an acceptable noise level is attained.
 - 3. Mufflers must be in place at all times.
 - 4. Cars losing mufflers or exhaust pipes during an event will not be allowed to continue.

Tires 1. Only Track approved tires, purchased at Shenandoah Speedway are permitted. (Hoosier F-45 Tire)

- 2. Tires will be purchased on race day. 3. 2 Tire Rule, 4 Tire Nights will be on of races 150 Laps or more. 4. All tires will be subject to impound after race by Shenandoah Speedway Officials. Impounded Tires are to only be used on the car they came off of. (No buying for one car and using for different car the following week.) 5. Tire soaking is not allowed at anytime.
- **6.** Any violations will be loss of points, fines and suspension. Any Tires can be used for Practice at Shenandoah Speedway
